# A New Option in Pooled Trusts



As a (501)(c)(3) non-profit, BIAWA acts as the Trustee. BIAWA is partnering with industry leaders in financial and trust management to offer beneficiaries exceptional customer service.

Funds put in to a Pooled Trust are stored safely, along with money from other grantors. Assets are managed for more stable administration and investment options. Accurate records are kept of each sub-account, and distributions are made for the beneficiary's supplemental needs as requested.

In the case of Pooled Special Needs Trusts (SNTs), the beneficiary is able to maintain eligibility for public benefits.

#### WHAT DOES PACT OFFER?

#### **Basic Support and Maintenance (BSM)**

BSM Trusts can be set up for any beneficiary, not just individuals affected by disability

#### **First Party Special Needs Trust**


Grantor of the Trust is a person affected by disability

#### **Third Party Special Needs Trust**

Grantor(s) of the Trust are parents or family members of a person affected by disability
